Cozy ringlets. Lips like mayan flowers.

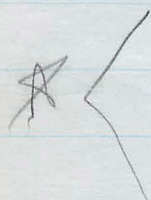

10. E + G's room - #22 on the second floor.
11. "I'm happy as cheese" / "Cake as moonlight"
12. Mint tea + crystallized ginger wrapped in pearfruit leaves (p 71)
13. Galinda believed "she would adorn the ball as being w/ her beauty + occasional clever sayings."
 ("She had wanted to be a sort of living marble bust.")
 (It wasn't actually based on Galinda that there was more to learn + that she was expected to do it.)

15. Elphaba reading: "Does Evil exist?"
 G: "Oh, yawn. Evil exists ... + its name is Boredom."
16. G to FF + Sh-Sh re Elphaba: "I entered it only so I could tell you"
17. M1 - "... unpleasant disruptions we have been hearing about in our nation's capital" (p. 83)
18. Dr. D - Years ago, back in the reign of the Regent, (I) used to be invited annually to lecture @ Briscoe Hall. But the restrictions changed that (p. 106)
19. "Safe keep the Wizard's laws + the wizard's laws will keep you safe"

20. Doctor D's work in natural sciences, trying to determine what the real differences were between "human and talking animals tissue... The literature... doesn't hold up to scientific scrutiny... Without our Wizard, we'd have been swept away in a firestorm, years ago."
24. Madame M: "I am a hard worker at the service of (my) superior."
25. E: "I'll find a place to study on my own. But I don't know yet where I'm going. I haven't decided so I wouldn't have to lie to you."

26. The Wizard's reclusiveness: "He shows up @ The opera and listens behind a portable screen. At his own formal dinner he dines apart, in an adjoining chamber behind a carved marble grill." (p. 186)

27. Elphaba: "Becoming. A perfect word for my new life. I, who have always been unbecoming, am becoming 'us'."

28. Glinda: "I'm not as dumb as I act."

Also: "Some things going on in your life... something good + bad at the same time. (Maybe I can help.)"

29. ^{Fox on} Nema becoming Governor (if she's older?): "It's your bisphright."

30. Elphaba on Nessanore: "I gave her my childhood."

31. Glinda in her gown -- "looks like a huge Glindaberry bush"
